

WORKING WITH PROMPT

To use colored string with terminal prompt, the terminal prompt is not wrapping correctly with very long commands. You need `prompt=true` to tell *Str* to fix these issues:

```
prompt = Str('colored prompt# ', color='red', prompt=True)
```
